IMPORTANT DATES

January 22 – Final date for submissions for grad pictures for the yearbook

February 5 – Grad Overnighter

- Please join us for the Grad Overnighter which is being held here at SHS. Tickets are \$12 and will be available during the week before exams at lunch time in top floor “C” Lobby.

April 14 – Graduation Fee (\$40) and Orders for Grad Gowns, Caps, and Tassels are due

- Payment is to be made (cash only, please) to Jeanne in the Office.
- Please make certain that you have given your Gown Order Form to Mrs. McFarlane.
- Invitations to the graduation ceremony will be issued to only those students who have paid the \$40 Grad Fee.

June 12 – Tickets for the Graduation Dance at the Delta Brunswick Hotel

- Tickets are available in the office at a cost of \$15 per person.
- We hope that all graduates will attend this event.

June 14 – Final Exams Begin

- We encourage you to prepare for your exams. Good Luck!

June 24 – GRADUATION REHEARSAL

- At 8:30 a.m., graduates return to homeroom to pick up their home reports.
- Graduates report to the Cafeteria at 9:00 a.m. for the Graduation Rehearsal. There, you will be given a place in the procession, which will move to the Gymnasium.
- All graduates must attend the rehearsal. Important information is given to graduates at that time.
- At the rehearsal, invitations to the graduation ceremony will be issued. **Each graduate (who has paid the grad fee) will receive four invitations.** Because of the large demand for invitations, any graduate who has extra invitations is asked to return them to the office so that other graduates may use them.
- If any guests require special seating due to physical challenges, please inform Mrs. McFarlane no later than June 18.
- Grad caps and tassels will be available after the rehearsal.

June 24 – GRADUATION REHEARSAL (Continued)

- Graduation gowns may be signed out from the Music Room or Pool Room following the rehearsal. **Whether the grad gown is issued on rehearsal day or on graduation night, the gown must be returned on graduation night immediately following the graduation ceremony.** All gowns must be returned in the condition that they were received. Each graduate is to return his/her gown to the teacher at the location from which it was issued.
- SHS rents the gowns, and must charge an \$85 replacement fee for any gowns that have been damaged or not returned.

June 25 – Graduation Dance at the Delta Brunswick Hotel

- The Grand March begins at 8:00 p.m.
- The Graduation Dance begins at 8:30 p.m.
- We encourage your family to come and view the Grand March. Due to space restrictions, and Fire Marshall Regulations, there will not be a parent-grad first dance.
- Flewwelling Photography will be available to photograph you and your date. (Envelopes to request this sitting will be available in the Office in early June.)

June 28 – Graduation Ceremony

- At 6:30 p.m. Graduates are to meet in the MUSIC ROOM or the POOL ROOM (bottom Floor C) to pick up Grad Gowns (if you have not already) and prepare for the ceremonies.
- There will be signs indicating from which room each graduate will pick up her/his gown.
- If you leave the area for pictures, please return to the hallway by the cafeteria by 7:00 p.m. to line up in preparation for the procession to the gym.
- Doors open to the gymnasium at 6:45 p.m. Only those guests with invitations will be admitted to the ceremony.
- The graduation ceremony begins at 7:30 p.m.
- Photography Flewwelling will be available to take photographs of you receiving your diploma and/or awards during the ceremony. You may request this service by completing an order envelope. These are available in the School Office and will be available in early June.
- **Immediately after the ceremony, please return your gown to the room where you got it.**
- Everyone is invited to join us in the Cafeteria immediately following the ceremony for cake and punch.

Extra Graduation Invitations

- If you require more than four invitations to the ceremony, please complete a request form. These are available at the School Office.
- The completed requests are to be given to Mrs. McFarlane as soon as possible. Any extra invitations will be distributed **based on availability** and **in the order that the requests were received**.
- Requests for extra invitations or special seating/parking cannot be accepted after June 18.

Conduct Guidelines

Our Graduation Ceremony is an opportunity for you to be honored and recognized for your achievements. Please observe the following guidelines:

- Be present for the rehearsal. This is the only opportunity for graduates to learn important details in preparation for graduation night.
- You may wear your grad cap and tassel during the ceremony. However, please do not wear baseball caps or other headgear.
- Leave cell phones, pagers, iPods or any other electronic devices at home or with your parents/guardians.
- Do not chew gum during the ceremony.

Conduct Guidelines (Continued)

- Please do not talk during the ceremony.
- Wear your grad gown during the entire ceremony. It is advisable to wear lightweight clothing under your gown.
- Remain seated during the entire ceremony.
- Ask your guests not to approach you
- during the ceremony.
- Before you leave the school on Graduation night, return your gown to the same area from which you got it.

Guidance Note

All graduates must sign a sheet in the Guidance Center by June 25 indicating where you wish to have your final transcript forwarded. If you receive any bursaries or awards before graduation, inform your Guidance Counsellor. Graduates are reminded that any prizes, bursaries, or scholarships should be acknowledged with a letter of thanks. If you have any questions, please contact the Guidance Department.
